Relationships and Sexuality Education (RSE)

Programme: Teachers will be delivering this programme over the rest of this term. Keep a look out for the *Busy Body Booklets* and *The Big Talk Booklets* in your child's bag. These are used by parents as an aid to talk to their child about relationships. Teachers will send out an explanatory email before they are sent home. We find that pupils who are given *an opportunity to discuss these issues with their parents* at home before it is taught in school *have a better experience* engaging with the material in school.

STEM News

ESB Science Blast, RDS: This exhibition of primary schools' work in Science is open to the public if any families would like to visit. We were chosen to exhibit there last year and won an award! Our pupils will engage with *Engineers Week (4/3/24 - 8/3/24)* at the start of the month and some of our 6ths will go on a field trip to TUD to celebrate it. Bayside students will also be involved in our own *Bayside SNS Climate Action Project* between the midterm and Easter. The pupils will learn to gather data about Climate Change by engaging as scientists with anemometers, rain gauges and thermometers.
